- case management to link clients with needed community supports;
- collaboration with probation officers, social workers, school staff, other professionals and other community resources;
- crisis intervention;
- skill building (i.e., anger management, parenting, impulse control, limit setting, positive communication);
- referrals to behavioral health, substance use and co-occurring disorders residential treatment programs;
- medication evaluation and management;
- discharge planning from psychiatric hospital and residential programs;
- participate on Family Assessment and Planning Teams (FAPT) and provide FAPT case management;
- intensive care coordination for youth on probation in FAPT-funded residential placements to facilitate a safe, timely return to the community.
