CAPS acts on complaints or information from residents that deal with quality of life issues. Citizens' Academies - effective community policing is based on relationships built on mutual trust and understanding. Numerous Citizen Police academies have been held, as well as academies tailored to the needs of the Hispanic and Asian communities, the faith community, the school system and youth. The curriculum covers a variety of topics ranging from gun and drug use in the City to how murder is investigated. Theme academy graduates are eligible for Neighborhood Assistance Officers.
