Individuals live in homes located within the community, which provide an opportunity to participate in community activities. Transportation services are provided for scheduled events.

Grafton group homes for adults require long-term living arrangements. The adults served, qualify for the intermediate level of care programs funded by Medicaid's Community-Based Waiver programs.
