The Hopewell City Health Department is part of the Crater Health District. Its mission is to achieve and maintain optimum personal and community health for its residents by emphasizing health promotion, disease prevention, and environmental

protection. Most services are provided on a sliding fee scale based on income and include:

- Family Planning
- HIV/AIDS Testing
- Immunizations
- Substance Use
- Sexually Transmitted Illnesses (STI) Testing and Treatment
- Communicable Disease Control
- Women, Infants & Children (WIC) Nutrition
- Emergency Preparedness & Response
- Environmental Health
- Vital Records--birth and death certificates
