Radford Transit is a public transit system for the citizens of Radford, Radford University students, faculty and staff, and those who live in the surrounding areas. Radford Transit is operated by New River Valley Community Services (NRVCS). All Radford Transit buses are accessible for mobility devices, such as wheelchairs, electric scooters, walkers, and crutches. Drivers are trained to assist

disabled passengers boarding or exiting the vehicle.

Visit the website to see live routes. Buses are wheelchair and scooter accessible and are equipped with bike racks. There is a trip planner on the website.

No fare is being charged.
