- The CBOC is handicapped accessible.
- Referrals for specialty services through the Salem Veterans Affairs Medical Center.
- Routine laboratory and x-rays as requested by the provider at the clinic.
- Medications as prescribed by the provider at the clinic, and processed through the mail.
- Preventive health screenings.
- Mental Health services are available and include individual, group, and family counseling, and programs such as Tobacco Cessation, Substance Abuse, and Depression/Pain Management and Women's Trauma Group.
