Centers are typically staffed with volunteers and paid peer-staff who ensure a safe, comfortable, and friendly atmosphere. People who come to the centers connect with (and find hope and inspiration from) a community of people in recovery. Peers encourage one another toward independence in housing, education, and jobs.

The Center serves the Route 1 corridor, the Eleanor Kennedy Shelter residents and other people who are homeless. Laundry, shower, and other resources are available.
